By notifying your loved ones of your funeral plan, this should alleviate some stresses on them as they work through this difficult time.

We suggest that you fill this form out with the assistance of loved ones, that you leave one copy in their possession, attach a copy to your will, and that you forward one copy to the parish you wish to conduct your funeral. If you have pre-planned your funeral already with a local funeral home, you may want to provide them with a copy of this instrument as well.
